RESOLUTION NO. 13

RE: PUBLIC SAFETY – REMOTE CONTROL LOCOMOTIVES

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming has a duty to provide for the public safety of its Citizens; and

WHEREAS, railroad equipment, including the use of remote control locomotives is known to present significant danger to persons and property from collision, derailment, and possible release of hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, the United States Government has issued a safety alert against vandalism and terroristic threats against railroads; now and therefore be it

RESOLVED, that the Wyoming State AFL-CIO requests that in the interest of the safety of the Citizens of the State of Wyoming, that locomotives will be manned by a Certified locomotive Engineer in the cab of the locomotive for its Safe Operation.
