**RESOLUTION TO ENCOURAGE SAFETY
OF REMOTE CONTROL LOCOMOTIVES**

BY THE CLERK:

WHEREAS, the City of Flint has a duty to provide for the public safety of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, railroad equipment, including the use of remote control locomotives is known to present significant danger to persons and property from collisions, derailment and possible release of hazardous materials; and

WHEREAS, the United States government has issued a safety alert against vandalism and terrorist threats against railroads; and

WHEREAS, the Flint City Council believes that it is not in the best interest of our residents to see this technology put into place without a thorough and comprehensive survey;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Flint City Council requests that in the interest of the safety of the citizens of Flint, Michigan, that the Federal Railroad Administration conduct a comprehensive and thorough review of the safety of remote control locomotives to ensure that the safety and well-being of the citizens of Flint will not be jeopardized by the use of such devices.


